EUROPEAN UNIVERSITIESORIENTEERING CHAMPIONSHIP 2019



PROLOGUE WAS SUCCESSFUL

On Tuesday afternoon began the sport part of 1. European University Orienteering Championship with prologue. IT took place in Prostějov with base in Sportcentrum - DDM. The winner of women cathegory was Marita Hotz (Bern University of Applied Sciences), the next medals stay in Czechia as the second place won Johanka Šimková (Mendel University in Brno) and third place took Petra Hančová (University of Hradec Králové). The fourth and fifth place went to Switzerland thanks to Katrni Müller and Deborah Stadler (both Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Zürich) the last on the podium on the sixth place was Jana Pekařová, who attends a project (Orienteering academy for talented youngsters organized by Marek Cahel) held as a part of whole event. The men cathegory clearly won David Von Arx (Bern University of Applied Sciences), second pace took Viacheslav Martynovskii (Saing-Petersburg State University of Aerospace Instrumentation) bronz medal went to Daniil Kashin from the same university. Fourth place was shared by Petr Horvát (Brno University of Technology) and George Emilian Minoiu (University of Craiova). On sixth place finished Nikolai Kudriavtcev (Saint-Petersburg State University of Aerospace Instrumentation).

The representatives of students (Tereza Janošíková from UP Olomouc and Ondřej Vystavěl from VUT Brno), officials and functionaries will make a vow.
